



A cookie is a small text file used in Austria and by many websites worldwide to identify users who regularly use its sites. Cookies cannot enter the user's system and cause damage there. Cookies on the Schrack site contain absolutely no information about you, but only a special code which only has a meaning for the Schrack internet site. These cookies can be used to see how users make use of the website. If you do not wish to benefit from cookies, you can easily deactivate/activate them in your browser. To do so, please refer to the setting options for your individual browser. Where the cookie will be saved in the user's system is controlled by the user's WWW browser. Cookies are informations which are returned to the server the next time the user visits the site. They can only be read by the same server which stored them previously. Schrack only uses cookies when they are absolutely necessary for user functions or when they make the navigation of web pages easier. This information is not made available to third parties as cookies are used for the aforementioned purposes only.
